**The Sunset Diner**



Our location on Queen Street West has been serving the hospitality needs of St. Marys for over fifty years. In the early years the St. Marys Fairgrounds with its unique covered racetrack was located right next door.

In 1954 Philip Nellis constructed five tourist cabins just to the west of his Reliance gas station. The cabins were deemed very modern and came with a television in each unit.

In 1959 Patrick and Marjorie Gardner purchased the tourist camp, now known as the West Court Motel, and opened a coffee

shop. A Lyric Theatre flyer from 1960 displays an ad for the West Court Motel which reads: "After the show enjoy a snack at the West Court motel. Our specials, footlong hot dogs, hamburgers, phone 1151".

Over the years the motel and coffee shop passed through the hands of a number of owners. Local diners may remember the coffee shop under the banner of the Sunset Café or Kay's Kitchen. Although the motel was demolished many years ago, the coffee shop continued to serve the needs of locals and tourists passing through. Until the opening of Wildwood Dam

and the bypass, Highway #7 passed directly through St. Marys and Queen Street was a busy thoroughfare.

In April 2002, Dave Steward purchased the Diner from Bradan Furtney. Since that time the restaurant was renovated and expanded the growing needs of the community. The outdoor patio was opened to the public and three years ago the Diner were granted a liquor license. Although The Sunset Diner is well renowned for our breakfasts, the menu has changed over the years to satisfy the various appetites of the customers. One of the recent changes was to

have 'A Wings and Beer Night' on Thursdays. This was such a great success the hours for Thursdays were expanded and the Sunset Diner is now open from 4 pm to 11 pm to accommodate all the people who want to take advantage of this fabulous meal. There are over twenty varieties of wings to choose from and everybody seems to have their own favourite. Even though all these changes have taken place, there is one thing one can count on and that is no matter what day it is, the friendly atmosphere and delicious home-cooked food remains the same.
